Should I attend Mass If I'm Sick?

During cold and flu season, each of us has the responsibility of taking precautions to prevent the spread of illness. Here are some things to keep in mind when it comes to the cold/flu and Mass. The sign of peace: Please don't be offended if someone chooses not to shake hands with you during the sign of peace. An appropriate gesture might be to strive for eye contact rather than physical contact. You could clasp your hands together and bow gently to those around you, and with a smile say "Peace be with you".

Lenten Observance

Weekdays of Lent: volunteer acts of love and self-denial are recommended.
Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence from meat.
On meals: Fasting on these days means we can have only one full, meatless meal. Some food can be taken at the other regular meal times if necessary, *but combined they should be less than a full meal*. Liquids are allowed at any time, but no solid food should be consumed between meals.
This applies to all people between 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence includes all Fridays of Lent.
All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.
